First class wining and dining in Tasmania's Tamar Valley

The Experience - 7 hours

Discover the cool climate wines of the Sparkling Pipers and Tamar Valley's Relbia wine regions on this full day wine tasting tour. With a friendly guide to take care of you, you can sample wines and local food without a care in the world. Visit up to five cellar doors and talk to the passionate staff about these sensational beverages.



Take time to appreciate the spectacular views of the Pipers River and Relbia wine regions. Enjoy three great vineyards in the Pipers River region, with a climate close to that of Champagne in France, this region is known simply as 'Sparkling Tasmania'. We lunch and finish testing our taste buds, south of Launceston in the Relbia wine region.

Jansz Tasmania - Start the journey with the bubbles of Jansz Tasmania sparkling wines - a rustic and beautiful old timber winery where Jansz began is now a stunning state-of-the-art cellar door and interpretation centre set beside a lake amidst vines and wandering geese.



Delamere Vineyard - A delightfully rustic cellar door and one of Tasmania's longest running family operated wine estates, focused on producing distinguished sparkling and still wines from the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay varieties.



Bay of Fires Vineyard - at Pipers River in Northern Tasmania, is nestled in lush towering woodlands along the banks of the river and is the home to the Bay of Fires range of cool climate wines, including Eddystone Point and the House of Arras range, Australia's prestigious sparkling wines.

Sharman's Vineyard at Relbia - Located on the banks of the North Esk River in Relbia, south of central Launceston. Sharmans premium wines include Pinot Noir, Cabernet Merlot, Chardonnay, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Noble Late Harvest and Sparkling Chardonnay/Pinot.



Lunch at Wine tasting at Josef Chromy

Set among old English gardens and stands of 100-year-old oak trees, and overlooking a picturesque lake, Josef Chromy Wines cellar door and restaurant is a stunning location to experience superb Tasmanian wines and fine cuisine made with fresh local produce.
