The Campfire Dinner

With the forester kangaroos as your dinner companions, enjoy the ambience of campfire dining with a 4 course dinner consisting of Tasmanian tasting platter of cheeses and smoked meats followed by wallaby mountain burgers and native spiced salmon with dessert to finish. Settle back and relax with a Tassie beer or wine and watch the sun set and see our field of dreams come alive.



The Wildlife Experience

You will be delighted and enchanted while sitting by the campfire as the wildlife appear at dusk. Forester kangaroos, eastern quolls, Tasmanian pademelons and brush-tail possums feed near the campfire while Bennett's wallabies and wombats graze close by. At times, platypus, tawny frogmouths, bandicoots and owls can also be viewed.
