



Ben Lomond & Campfire Lunch with the Kangaroos

Craggy Alpine Peaks, Campfire Dining & Tasmanian Beverages

The Experience - 7 hours

A day in the wilderness on this Tasmania day tour while visiting the magnificent craggy alpine peaks of Ben Lomond National Park before moving on for a relaxing afternoon campfire lunch with the kangaroos



Ben Lomond National Park

Tour departs at 9.30 am to visit the spectacular Ben Lomond plateau which is the largest alpine plateau in Tasmania, and is a mountain environment with extensive and dramatic dolerite cliffs and columns. Its scree slopes, swirling mists and frost-stunted forests are reminiscent of a Tolkien landscape. We drive Jacobs Ladder, a series of hairpin bends to marvel at the breathtaking view from the platform at the top. The Ben Lomond plateau has 8 of the 20 highest peaks in Tasmania and it has the highest drivable point in Tasmania where Bennett's wallaby and wombats may be seen in daylight hours.



The Forests

In leaving Ben Lomond we travel the Roses Tier forests stopping along the way to forage for sassafras and native pepper forest spices to add a bush flavour to your lunch.

The Campfire Lunch

With the forester kangaroos as your lunch companions, enjoy the ambience of campfire dining with a 4 course lunch consisting of Tasmanian tasting platter of cheeses and smoked meats followed by wallaby mountain burgers and native spiced salmon with dessert to finish. Settle back and relax with a Tassie beer or wine on a relaxing afternoon.
