The Tassie Wilds

Awesome views and a magnificent array of alpine vegetation are on offer. Ben Lomond plays an invaluable role in regional wildlife conservation and is Tasmania's highest drivable point.



The Campfire Dinner

With the forester kangaroos as your dinner companions, enjoy the crackling campfire, dining on a 3-course dinner consisting of Tasmanian tasting platter of cheeses, smoked meats and fruit followed Bush Campfire Bush Burgers or Native Spice Salmon/Salad with dessert to finish. The Wildlife

As twilight deepens, the campfire scene transforms into a Tasmanian wildlife theatre: forester kangaroos, pademelons, eastern quolls, possums, and even wallabies quietly drift into view around the fire. In this magic hour, critters settling in for the night, making it one of Australia's most memorable after-dark wildlife experiences.
