The Experience - 2 days & 2 nights

Day 1 & 3 - Self-drive or Pepper Bush transfer arrival & departure

Day 2 - Platypus & Pipers Brook and Tamar River wine regions



Day 1 - Ben Lomond & Quoll Patrol

Seasonal departure - Visit Ben Lomond National Park, a spectacular mountain of dolerite columns and scree slopes and Tasmania's highest drivable point. See impressive views and a stunning array of alpine vegetation. Leaving Ben Lomond we travel through the Roses Tier forests to the Tyne Valley for a campfire dinner with the kangaroos. Relax by the camp fire as our field of dreams comes alive with eastern quolls, brush-tail possums and Tasmanian pademelons visiting the camp fire as Bennett's wallaby and the bare-nosed wombats graze near-by.

Day 2 - Platypus & Tamar Valley Wines

Depart Scottsdale at 9.30 am to travel a short distance to view the fascinating platypus before travelling to the Pipers Brook and Tamar Valley wine regions. The diverse landscapes compliment visits to the vineyard cellar doors for a perfect for a day out. First up, we visit the impressive Delamere Vineyard Cellar Door, a true grower producer: from vine to bottle, everything happens on-site. Moving on we visit Marion's Vineyard which overlooks the Tamar River as does the Tamar Ridge Cellar Door. Lunch is at The Ducks Restaurant before finishing the day at Velo Wines before returning to Scottsdale around 4.30 pm
