Birding, Wildlife & Nature - 2 or 3 day tour

The Experience - 2 days /2 nights or 3 days /3 nights

Day 1 - Self-drive or Pepper Bush transfer arrival

Day 1 - Platypus, Birding & Quoll Patrol

Day 2/3 - Coastal birding - Bridport region

Day 2/3 - Birding - Northeast Tasmanian forests

Day 3/4 - Self-drive or Pepper Bush transfer departure



Day 1 - Quoll Patrol & Birding

Seasonal Departures - Depart Scottsdale to visit Ben Lomond National Park, a spectacular alpine mountain, or explore a variety of forests and bird habitats to discover forest and woodland birds on the way to the Tyne Valley for a 3-course campfire dinner with kangaroos. Relax by the camp fire as our field of dreams comes alive with eastern quolls, brush-tail possums and Tasmanian pademelons visiting the camp fire as Bennett's wallabies and the endearing bare-nosed wombats graze close-by.

Day 1/2 - Waterways and Coastal Reserves

Birds are abundant in local waterways and coastal areas with honey eaters, wrens, robins, finches, and pardalotes found in regions. It is also home to yellow tailed cockatoos, harriers, white bellied sea eagles and wedge-tail eagles. The Bridport Wildlife Flower Reserve and surrounding areas are known to be home to over 100 bird species including endemics, green rosella, yellow wattlebird, and yellow throated honeyeaters.

Day 2/3 - Birding Around the Region

The Scottsdale region offers a range of bird habitats - great diversity in proximity. We explore waterways, tall forests with undergrowth, open native eucalypt forests, plantations, farmlands and rolling hills. These areas are home to wrens, honeyeaters, robins, whistlers, parrots, thornbills, raptors, waterfowl, waders, fantails and many more. Eleven of Tasmania's twelve endemic species are known to north east Tasmania.

Overnight in Scottsdale - dinner own arrangements

Duration: Private Tour - 2/3 days / 2/3 nights (2 adult minimum)

Departing: Seasonal afternoon departures from Scottsdale - 12.00 - 2.00 pm

Inclusions: 2 nights B&B; Canopy Capers & Quoll Patrol tours; park passes;
