Departing Launceston we travel to the Meander Valley region to visit the Trowunna Wildlife Park for a private tour to meet the remarkable furry and feathered inhabitants. You will have the opportunity to interact with the forester kangaroos, cuddle a wombat and meet the Tasmanian devils and quolls. Trowunna Wildlife Sanctuary was the pioneer in Tasmanian devil breeding and rehabilitation. On leaving Trowunna we travel to the beautiful Tamar Valley wine region on the Tamar Wine Route
