Velo Wines

First cellar door for the day is Velo Wines. Originally established as Legana Estate in 1966, it is nestled at the gateway to Tasmania's Tamar Valley and is home to some of the island's oldest Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, and Shiraz vines.

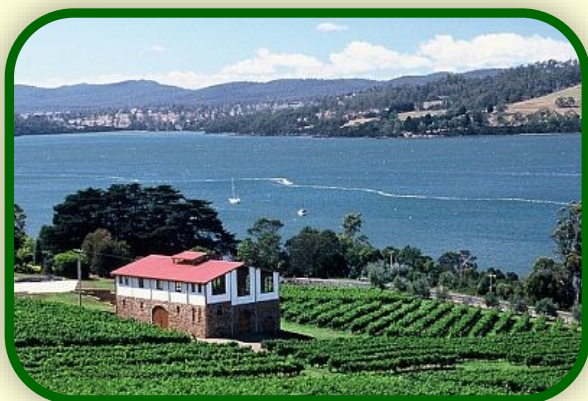


Moore's Hill Estate Vineyard

Moore's Hill is a boutique, family operated vineyard perched on the northern slopes of the Tamar Valley - where they produce estate-grown, single vineyard wines including sparkling, Riesling, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and a Cabernet Merlot blend

Marion's Vineyard

Now certified organic and biodynamic, this family run estate crafts a diverse portfolio—from crisp Chardonnay and Pinot Noir to rare warm climate reds like Syrah, Tempranillo, and Cabernet Franc

Nestled among the vineyards in the Tamar Valley and overlooking the Tamar River the Ducks Restaurant delivers modern Australian cuisine made from fresh, local Tasmanian produce

Tamar Ridge Cellar Door

Finish the day at the Tamar Ridge Cellar Door which offers immersive guided wine tastings - highlighting their acclaimed cool climate Pinot Noir and Pirie sparkling wines, all enjoyed with panoramic vineyard views.
