Platypus House

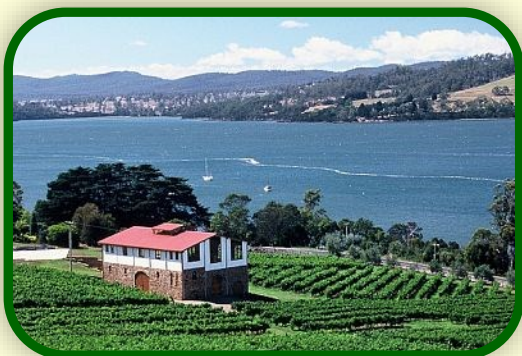
