Visit the Trowunna Wildlife Sanctuary to meet the Tasmanian devils, wombats, quolls and forester kangaroos. Travel to the beautiful Tamar Valley region for lunch at the River Café before continuing your wildlife journey to Platypus House



The River Cafe

Trowunna Wildlife Sanctuary

Departing Launceston we travel to the Meander Valley region to visit the Trowunna Wildlife Park for a private tour to meet the remarkable furry and feathered inhabitants. You will have the opportunity to interact with the forester kangaroos, cuddle a wombat and meet the Tasmanian devils and quolls. Trowunna Wildlife Sanctuary was the pioneer in Tasmanian devil breeding and rehabilitation. On leaving Trowunna we travel to the beautiful Tamar region.



Platypus House

Enjoy a guided, indoor experience where you can see Tasmanian platypuses swimming and diving in daylight conditions. Then, walking into the echidna garden, you'll sit or kneel as adorable echidnas wander around your feet, sniff between legs, and forage nearby - truly one of the few places where you can feel so close to these unique monotremes
